## Kid Powerwheels Derby Both Nights!

### GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Everyone must pay the \$8.00 gate admission fee
2. All vehicles inspected by the chief steward or his assistants for compliance with all safety regulations prior to the event. Their decision as to the qualification of the vehicle is final. Absolutely no arguing with the chief steward's decision.
3. Driver must be 18 years of age or older. Drivers 16 & 17 years of age may drive if a release is signed by an accompanying parent.
4. No Jeeps or convertibles. Pickup and Van class may only run 2WD. Small pickups and minivans may run 4WD. If there is a question on what class you should be in, call in advance!
5. NO PASSENGERS
6. NEW!!! Drivers must get car check-in sheet from inspector when inspected, prior to registration in office, so car can be placed in appropriate class!
7. Do NOT complain to women in fair office at any time. Complaints can be made, when time permits, to a race official
8. All drivers must pick up trophies and money at the completion of the event, or it will be forfeited. Money will not be mailed! Unclaimed checks will be voided after 60 days.
9. Driver may enter each heat but same vehicle may enter only 1 preliminary heat.
10. Drivers must sign entry blank form and demolition derby driver's release form prior to race time.

11. All drivers must be present for drivers meeting before the race at 6:45 p.m. on both nights.
12. Additional rules and regulations may be added or changed depending on safety regulations.
13. No use of drugs or intoxicants will be allowed on the track or pit areas. Offenders will be disqualified/expelled from the track
14. **No pitmen allowed in show arena during a heat.**
15. GAS LEAK - vehicle will be disqualified.
16. CAR FIRE - if car restarts and conditions are safe you will have one more chance before disqualification.
17. Reckless driving or reckless conduct when entering or exiting track or pit area will result in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees.
18. No deliberate head on or hitting opponent's truck in driver's door.
19. There will be no use of video equipment for replays to alter the officials decision.
20. All cars must run a preliminary heat in order to qualify for a feature or consolation race.
21. If a car is not useable for feature the driver may use another car to run in the feature if it has run in a preliminary race.

### WOMEN'S CLASS RULES

1. Car may be used in the regular derby or bring another car
2. All other rules apply
3. NO SUV's or Trucks in womens class. Cars only!

## BONE STOCK

1. All glass must be removed prior to entering the fairgrounds.
2. All lights and lenses must be removed.
3. Wire doors and trunk shut.
4. May leave the original gas tank and tank fill lid on.
5. Remove any airbags on the vehicle.
6. A bar may be added to drivers door. Max 6" in front and behind door.
7. FWD Cars Only!
8. You may move the battery for safety.

## PREPARATION OF VEHICLES

1. Please make car number as clear as possible. Steward may request removal of unacceptable words.
2. All glass and mirrors must be removed before reaching the fairgrounds.
3. It is strongly recommended to weld a cross bar behind the seat between door posts.
4. Roof Mounted car number boards and bars from hood to roof in front of driver are highly recommended.
5. Fuel cells are preferred over boat tanks, but original tanks can be used in fuel injected pressurized systems. Tanks must be behind driver and covered well! 10 gallons MAX!
6. SAFETY BELTS/ HELMETS ARE REQUIRED!!!
7. Cars only = All trunks must be empty of debris, spare parts, etc. / Trucks only = All beds must be empty of debris, spare parts etc
8. NO FLASHING LIGHTS ON VEHICLES.

## RWD - FWD WIRE CAR PREPARATION

1. Bumper may be welded but only 4" behind bumper.
2. May weld driver's door completely and 5" on and 5" off other side doors. No welding on rear doors or trunk lids.
3. One bar across dash and one bar behind seat no further than 4" from seat. May connect dash bar and seat bar with weld. May weld roll-over protection and cage around fuel tank. No connecting to frame! No other support anywhere else in the car!
4. Any tire allowed.

5. Frame and sheet metal may be notched or pre bent.
6. No welding on car unless stated. You may change radiator support mount 3/4 " bolt, may not extend hood.
7. Doors, trunk, hood and bumpers may be wired or chained.
8. Unlimited wire may be used.
9. Must be 18 years of age, 16 and 17 year olds need notarized permit with parent's consent.
10. Any rear end allowed.
11. Drivers MUST attend the meeting before the race.
12. Drivers will NOT drink alcohol before or during the race.
13. MUST wear approved racing helmets and seat belts.

## REMOVAL OF VEHICLES

Driver must remove his vehicle from the fairgrounds by 2:00 p.m. SUNDAY. Vehicles become property of Hend. Co. Fair if failure to comply. Vehicles left on the fairgrounds are at the drivers' risk.
