

- Entry forms may be mailed to: Henderson County Fair, P.O. Box 313, Stronghurst, IL 61480 or dropped into the indicated drop box at the Extention Office in Stronghurst.
- The judge has the right to disqualify any exhibit improperly entered.
- All livestock will be released following the Livestock Auction on Friday night, July 28. Premium checks may be picked up Sat, July 29 from 8 Noon. If you can not make it at this time please call (309) 924-1177 to make other arrangements.
- NO premium checks will be mailed.
- ENTRY DEADLINE for all projects is by 5:00 P.M. FRI, JULY 7, 2017. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!

CARE OF ANIMALS

- 1. Provide fresh, clean water to animals at all times. Keep your pens clean and dry with good bedding at all times. Animals should be treated humanely. Avoid stressing the animal.
- 2. Be aware of animal comfort requirements regarding temperature and space.
- 3. Sort and load animals safely and carefully.
- 4. Train animals to lead or be handled at a young age before the fair to make them manageable.
- 5. Arrange for veterinary care in case of an animal emergency.

- 6. Adhere to all antibiotic, drug, and water or feed additive withdrawal times.
- 7. Keep animals clean. A clean animal is viewed as a healthy animal.
- 8. Use show sticks, whips, and canes for showing only. Do not use electric prods.
- 9. Have a plan of action if a problem should arise. Contact superintendent or fair officials if needed.
- 10. If questioned about animal care by a stranger, be polite, answer the questions as best you can, and refer the person to the appropriate superintendent if a situation arises.

- Classes will be divided by Beef Committee according to ages of exhibitors.
